

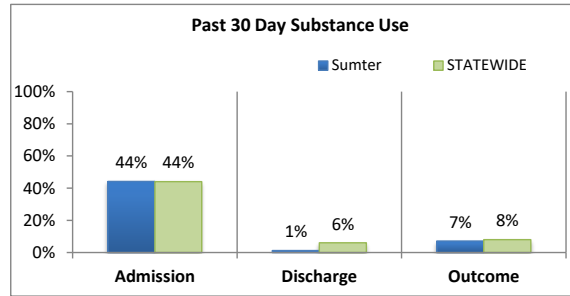
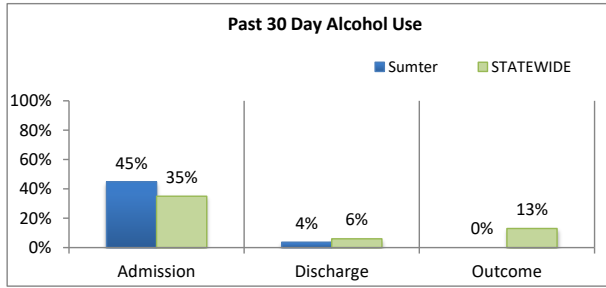

**Admission - Discharge - Outcome**

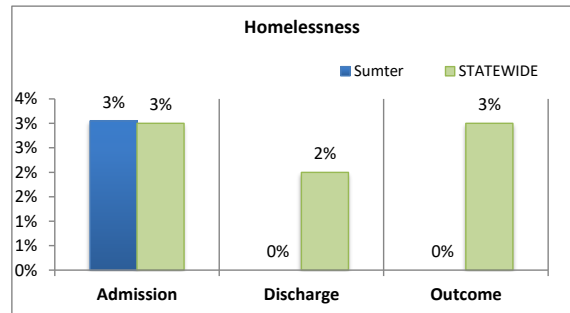
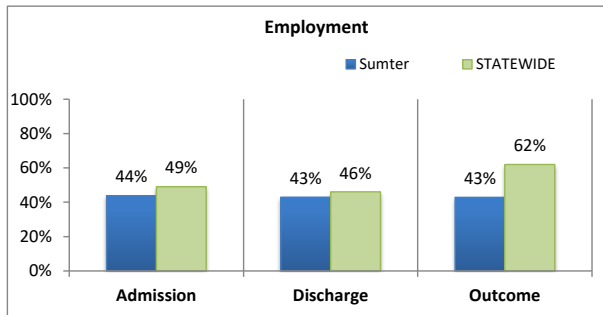
**Clients Discharged Between 7/1/2021 and 9/30/2021**

In South Carolina, publicly funded county-based substance abuse treatment centers are required to collect data on client substance abuse, employment, housing status, and criminal justice involvement at admission, discharge, and follow-up survey. Clients are surveyed approximately 2 - 3 months following discharge from treatment and the data is submitted to the S.C. Department of Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse Services (DAODAS) in Columbia, SC. This report represents highlights from the most recent fiscal year, FY2022-Q1.

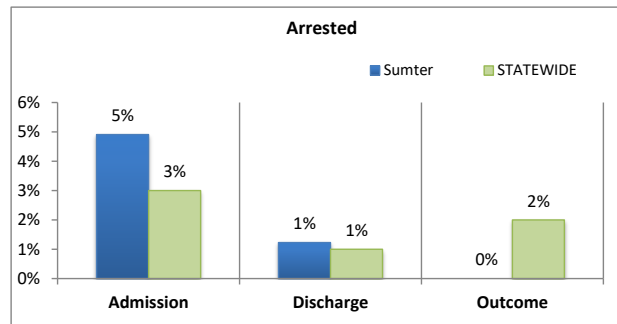
