Sumter Behavioral Health Services is seeking a qualified individual to fill the full-time position of **Clinical Counselor** Adolescent and Family Services.

Responsibilities: Position serves as Clinical Counselor reporting to the Clinical Director

Duties will include but are not limited to: providing clinical services including intake, assessment, case management, crisis intervention/management, individualized treatment plans, clinical placement and treatment of clients to include individual, family, and group therapy. Maintain contact with and conduct outreach with other community services and agencies to coordinate client services. Service include providing a full spectrum of treatment services to clients referred from within the Agency and other referral sources including Sumter Pediatrics, Liberty Steam Charter, and Sumter School District. Using a therapeutic background, the counselor will work with individuals and families to help resolve conflict and develop new coping skills. Counselor will work with a variety of clients including adolescents ages ranging from 5 to 19. Services to be rendered in school setting primarily, but also office based with Sumter Pediatrics and Sumter BHS. Will be a liaison for the agency within the school district when needed.

Special Skills: Excellent written and oral communication skills, knowledge of referral sources as it relates to the job, good computer skills in EHR system and Microsoft Office programs.

Requirements: Master's degree in the human services field from an accredited college/university required with experience in substance abuse counseling preferred. LMSW, LAC and/or LPC preferred. Must be certified as Addictions Counselor by SCAADAC within two years of hire date.
